Scripture Readings:

First Reading: Habakkuk: 1:2-3; 2:2-4. The prophet complains to God about the prevalence of injustice, and God responds by promising to save those who trust in him.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14. Paul encourages Timothy to be faithful to his ministry and to witnessing to Christ.

Gospel: Luke 17:5-10. A little faith, provided it is authentic, can do great things. The disciples are urged to serve God without any claim on a reward.

October is **Mission Month** in the Church, which culminates in World Mission Sunday on 19th October. During this Jubilee Year of Hope and, in particular, during this month, we are invited by Pope Leo to recall our baptismal vocation to share in the mission of the universal Church, "To go out to the whole world and spread the Good News" – the news of Hope in Christ. We can realise this through our prayers, sacrifices and financial support for the Church in 1100 mission dioceses in the world.
