Scripture Readings:

First Reading: 2 Kings 5: 14-17. On being cured of leprosy, Naaman comes to believe in the true God, and is lavish in his gratitude towards the prophet Elisha.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 2:8-13. Paul tells Timothy that the work of preaching the Gospel will result in hardship, opposition and persecution.

Gospel: Luke 7: 11-19. The story of ten people who were cured of leprosy by Jesus, and how only one came back to thank him.

We are called to be part of the Church's missionary efforts, supporting missionary priests, religious sisters and brothers, and lay catechists who provide loving service to those most in need. They play a crucial part in "going and inviting everyone to the banquet".
