## **Scripture Readings:**

Ecclesiasticus 35: 12-14, 16-19 The Lord is not deferential to the powerful but takes the side of the powerless. 2 Timothy 4: 6-8, 16-18 Paul speaks of his imminent death and reflects on his own deep faith. Luke 18: 9-14 Humility before God is a recurring theme in the readings: the Gospel describes the Pharisee and the tax collector.

Today is **World Mission Sunday**. We are called to be part of the Church's missionary efforts, supporting missionary priests, religious sisters and brothers, and lay catechists who provide loving service to those most in need. They play a crucial part in "going and inviting everyone to the banquet". As Catholics around the world( here at home and in the missions) gather at the Eucharist around the table of the Lord, let us pray for the Church's missionary work and offer our support to Missio Scotland for our brothers and sisters throughout the world. The special collection this weekend will be for the Pontifical Mission Societies – the Pope's official charity for oversees mission.
