Scripture Readings:

Isaiah 49:3, 5-6 — God's Chosen One will bring salvation to all peoples.

1 Corinthians 1:1-3 — Includes the very start of Paul's first letter to the people of Corinth, who Paul says are called to take their place among the saints; we'll be reading from that letter each week until the start of Lent in March.

John 1:29-34 — John the Baptist introduces Jesus to us as the Lamb of God, the Chosen One.

Ordinary Sundays for the Year of Matthew begin today, but this Sunday's gospel is always from John. Thus, we begin Ordinary time with an introduction to Jesus prior to his ministry. Today, only John the Baptist speaks. He introduces Jesus to his own disciples as "the Lamb of God". Jews chose a lamb from their flocks to offer to God at Passover. Jesus is God's choice of victim.; one who takes away the sins of the world.

The **Special Collection** last weekend for the Justice and Peace Commission raised £395 and the Crib collection over Christmas for the Holy Childhood raises £265. Thank you to parishioners.
